Brother Alephs,

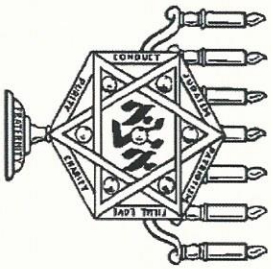

Programming - S'gan:

- Continue quality programming with location set in advance

Recruitment - Moreh:

- Adapt to the new recruitment process

How I plan to Steer the Chapter:

- Increase IC attendance.
